### About the Role

The project involves a 6-month long intervention being implemented across 100 government schools in the district of Champawath.

The role of the Research Associate (s) is to support and facilitate the researchers in implementing the above-mentioned intervention.

The position offers an opportunity to gain first-hand research management experience including field operations and interactions with Development economists, Policy Makers, and Grassroot level organizations while undertaking cutting-edge development research.

- **Understanding of Randomized Evaluations:** Demonstrating a good understanding of the value of RCTs and their usefulness for policy decisions is highly valuable.
- Work Authorization: Candidates must have work authorization to work in India. This covers citizens of India, Nepal, or Bhutan, Persons of Indian origin (PIO), and Overseas Citizens of India (OCI).
